When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry. Photocopies of support documents for all titles and accomplishments must be sent with entry; original documents must be available for inspection at the show. This is a German style conformation show.

- The decision of the Judge is final.
- No dog shall be permitted to enter any class with missing teeth.
- Dogs are shown in a natural stance (no hand stacking), and may be baited with toys at the judge's discretion. Baiting with food is generally prohibited by the judges.
- Double handling is permitted, and encouraged.
- Adult classes will be moved (run) long enough for the judge to evaluate dogs' movement and fitness. You may change handlers as needed.
- Event will be held outdoors, rain or shine.
- Bring your own chairs and anything else you may deem necessary for comfort for you and your dogs.
- **No dogs will be allowed within 50 feet of the show ring except those who are entered in the class that is being judged.**
- **No dogs may be tied out at show site or ringside. Please have a crate for each dog. No X-pens are allowed,**
- Please do not bring non-entered dogs to the show grounds.
- Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them.
- Dress is informal, sports attire is customary.
- Only Rottweilers with a valid USRC recognized registration (from AKC, CKC, USRC, or any FCI member Kennel Club) may participate
- Great food and beverages will be available at the show site Saturday and Sunday.

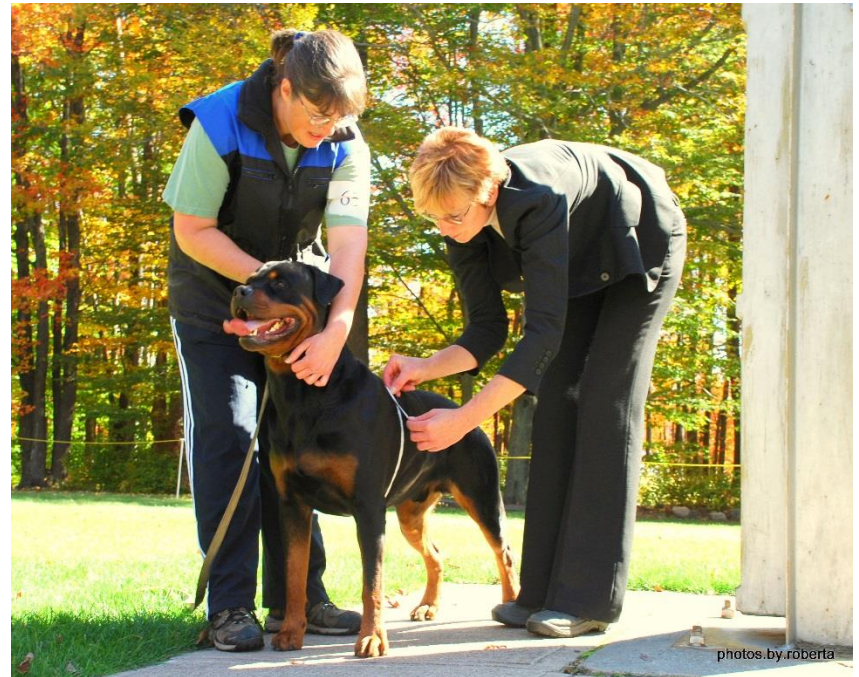

- **Working Male/Female** (For all Rottweilers 24 months and older with a USRC recognized SchH/VPG/IPO title).
- **Sieger/Siegerin Class** (For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Sieger/ Siegerin title at a USRC National or Regional Sieger show or have been awarded the USRC Universal Sieger/in title).

Non-Regular Classes

- **Veteran Male/Female** (For all Rottweilers 7 years or older on the day of the show. Veteran class entries are not eligible for titles and receive only critiques, no ratings or placements.
- **Kennel Group** (Three or more dogs bred by the kennel owner and registered with the kennel name of the entrant. All dogs must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry. A USRC recognized working title, breed test and USRC registration is required to be named Regional Sieger or Siegerin

Meet our Judge: Chantal Delafontaine, FCI - Belgium



In 1988 we bought our first ADRK Leistungszucht bitch "Mona vom Eisplatz", in 1989 "Olga vom Eisplatz" and in 1990 "Peggi vom Eisplatz".

With all these dogs we did social obedience, tracking and protection. We started to breed in 1989 under the kennel name "Du Dauchant" Da: Damien (our son), Au: Aure (our daughter), Chant: Chantal.

Our first aim was to breed a family dog with very good character, willing to work and of course, according to the breeding standard. We always took males from very good German bloodlines.

We got the owners of our puppies involved in showing and working with their dogs. We therefore created a K9club at home. In order to offer a good service I followed the training courses at the St Hubertus to become an obedience and tracking instructor. I passed the exams as an obedience instructor and also as an IPO instructor. We organized some obedience competition, IPO and even a Club Show.

I also followed the Ethology course at University of Namur and after being several times assistant to International Judges; I passed my theoretical exam in June 2001, in 2003 my practical exam and after having judged the Brussels Dog Show, I was qualified as International judge in 2005.

My education as a teacher pushes me always to improve my knowledge and the desire to pass it over to all real Rottweiler lover.

The Rottweiler is a strong and powerful dog, he gives you the feeling to be untouchable and gives you more self-assurance. These dogs would give their life for you, so never disappoint them. You have to teach him respect but never forget to play with him. Without natural trust nothing is possible. With every litter a new dream can start. Will one of them make you happy as a good friend, as a working dog; will one of them become a champion? All hopes and dreams are allowed! Our children also participated in the puppies education. They love to play with them.

Since 1999 St Hubertus allowed us to wear the title "Elite Sport Breeder". I'm very proud of this.

BSC Information

Copies of the following documents must be submitted with BSC entry.

- 1. Non USRC members may enter the BSC.**
2. Copy of USRC Registration for the dog being entered.
3. A working title is not needed to earn a BSC. If the dog has any working titles then a copy of scorebook showing titles earned, scorebook number, and full name of dog.
4. Copy of USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Copy of any prior BSC attempts.
6. Copy of Weight Certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. Copy of the USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

The following ORIGINAL documents must be submitted to the BST Secretary on the day of the Breed Test. Entry into the BSC will not be accepted without presenting these originals prior to taking the test.

1. USRC Registration Certificate for the dog being entered.
2. If the dog has any working titles then a scorebook showing titles earned, (minimum BH) scorebook number and full name of dog.
3. USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
4. Prior BSC attempts.
5. Weight certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
6. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the registration certificate.

BST Information

Copies of the following documents must be submitted with BST entry.

1. Copy of USRC Membership Card for both owner & handler.
2. Copy of USRC Registration for the dog being entered.
3. Copy of scorebook showing titles earned, scorebook number, and full name of dog. If the BH is earned after the close of entries, a copy of the scorebook showing the BH title must be presented to the BST secretary on the day of the Breed Test.
4. Copy of USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Copy of any prior BST attempts.
6. Copy of Weight Certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. A copy of the USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

The following ORIGINAL documents must be submitted to the BST Secretary on the day of the Breed Test. Entry into the BST will not be accepted without presenting these originals prior to taking the test.

1. USRC Membership Card for both owner & handler. A copy of the Membership card will be accepted on the day of the show. This exception to the original document requirements applies to the membership cards only.
2. USRC Registration Certificate for the dog being entered.
3. Scorebook showing titles earned, (minimum BH) scorebook number and full name of dog.
4. USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Prior BST attempts.
6. Weight certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.
